In the development of an educational institution, the involvement of alumni is crucial. The alumni of Government Arts & Science College, Kozhikode actively contributes to all the endeavors related to enhancing students' learning experiences and extracurricular activities in the campus. During the academic year 2022-23, numerous programs were conducted under the leadership of the college alumni.

On June 28, 2022 a commemorative event was held in the college auditorium to honor the legacy of Professor Eechavariyar, who had served as the Head of the Hindi Department at Government Arts & Science College, Kozhikode during his tenure from 1971 to 1975. This event was organized under the patronage of the Old Students' Association (OSA). The event commenced with an inaugural ceremony led by Professor Hameed Chennamangaloor and featured a keynote address delivered by Justice Baiju Nath, a distinguished member of the Kerala Human Rights Commission.





In 2019, Arts College Sahridaya Vedhi, in collaboration with the Old Students' Association (OSA), initiated a scholarship program in memory of Professor E. Soman, a distinguished cultural critic and former faculty member of the English Department. This scholarship was aimed to extend financial assistance to a deserving student from economically disadvantaged background for a duration of one academic year. support the student who excelled both in academics and extracurricular activities in that year. During the academic year 2022-23, this scholarship was awarded to a student pursuing studies in the Physics Department. On August 31, 2022 Dr. Edakkotte Shaji, the Principal of the college, awarded the scholarship to Miss. Aagna, in the presence of OSA members and representatives from Arts College Sahridaya Vedhi.



The Chemistry Alumni Association generously sponsored the establishment of a state-of-the-art smart room within the department, contributing a total of Rs. 92,360. These funds were amassed through contributions from various alumni batches. 





Alumni executive meetings of the chemistry department were held on 27.1.2022, 17.2.2022 and 22.3.2022 to resolve various programs of Alumni Association.




The yearly alumni meeting of the botany department alumni was held on 16-03-2022 at 7.30




OLD STUDENTS ASSOCIATION (OSA) REPORT 2020-21
