The PG and Research Department of Commerce as a part of MERIT 2022 organized Flames in Frames a documentary fest with a view to bring out some positive energy within the students. The event started by 10:30 am and was organized in the seminar hall. The event was graced by director Unnikrishnan Avala, director Aneez K Mappila, director Mohammed A and the Head of the department Dr. Dinesh PK. The event was organized for 100 students and it was attended by students of various departments. The event began with a welcome speech by anusree followed by the screening of the 1st documentary movie, Womenses- Distancing her from the divine by Unnikrishnan Avala. The movie speaks of how women fought to reclaim their rights to perform the ritualistic art form of Theyyam. Man is free to make changes in the codes of tradition to his convenience while women are being locked intoits confines. The film questions us about why women are only asked to be mere spectators and not participants of the ritual. The movie kept us thinking whether there's any development in the society of today from the society that we lived 10 years back. The movie has a duration of 60 minutes. The 2<sup>nd</sup> documentary movie was The Slave Genesis by Aneez K Mappila. The film revolves around the Paniyar community of the wayanad district and the socio-economic problems plaguing their community. It narrates the story of a community that was uprooted from the forest and freedom and forced to work for centuries on the plantations and fields of settlers who came from the plains. The Paniyars, like most Adivasis in India, were reluctant totalk about their lives to strangers and they were not too keen about showing their face for the camera either. Hence the director did face certain difficulties while documenting the people of paniyar and their lives. From a death and the superstitions surrounding it, the film takes us through various facets of the Paniya life. The film was compiled of shots taken by the director in a course time of 4 years. And it is for this effort and dedication of the director that he won the 65<sup>th</sup> National Award for the Best Anthropological Film. The film's duration was 80 minutes. The 3<sup>rd</sup> documentary was Jalasamadhi by Mohammed A. the movie revolves around the plight of the people living in Munroe Thuruth in Kollam - an island which's in the eye of an environmental disaster. Struggling to face the threat, people on the island are left with no option but to migrate to other places. While inviting public attention to the issues of the villagers, the documentary demands urgent measures to address the issue. The movie has a duration of 30 minutes. The 4<sup>th</sup> documentary was 21 Hours: A story of toil, travel and trade by Sunitha CV. The film gives us an insight into how Rajamma; a fisherwomen's livelihood has been affected by policies and situations that are not in her hands. The title of Sunitha CV's short documentary comes from the number of hours Rajamma puts into each day to earn and survive. Her day begins at 3am by travelling to Thoothukudy harbour 200 km away to procurefish and sell it back in her hometown and ends by midnight. She has faced both intimidation and discrimination as she was working in a field where men dominated the workplace, yet she never gave up. Her children have all established themselves in different careers, but Rajamma continues this life as it is all she knows. The film shows the struggle faced and

strength shown by the women of the unorganized workplace. The film has a duration of 30 minutes. After the screening of each movie, there was an interactive session between the directors of the movies and the audience after which they gave more information about their films and the difficulties they faced while shooting them.
