ANNUAL REPORT – 2018-2019

The college NCC unit under 30 Kerala Battalion, Calicut was established on 1967; consists of 106 cadets including 48 boy cadets (SD-Senior Division) and 58 girl cadets(SW-Senior Wing). Capt. Sreejith.K, Asst. professor Post Graduate department of History lead the College NCC unit as Associate NCC Officer (ANO). Mohammed Althaf P. P, U.G. student, P.G. Dept. of Economics is the senior most cadet and possess the rank of Senior Under Officer, Vishnu. K (3rd year B.Sc. Chemistry), Vignesh. C (3rd year B.Com) and Naveen Theja.K.P (3rd year B.Sc. Physics) are the SD & SW Under Officers respectively.

Formally the activities of this academic year began with the Independence day celebration on 15th August 2018. The Principal Dr. S. Jayasree hoisted the national flag and addressed the gathering. On 4th of June we conducted a blood donation awareness programme; campaigning class was led by the treasurer of Kerala Blood Donors' forum Mr. Fawaz.
