


The SC/ST Cell was formed with the Principal, Dr. S. Jayasree, as chairperson, Dr. Bhargavan as convener, Dr. Stalin Das P., Ms. Divya (office staff), and Ranjith Raghu (3rd B.Sc. Physics student) as members.

The cell members verified the admission records, noting that out of the 110 seats reserved for SC/ST students, 102 were filled in the UG courses. In the 26 seats reserved for SC/ST students in the PG courses, 25 were filled. Rules, regulations, scholarship details, and other relevant information were explained to newly admitted students during the induction program coordinated by IQAC.

The first and second meetings of the cell were held on 20.08.2018 and 10.11.2018, respectively, in the Seminar Hall, presided over by the principal. The cell assisted SC/ST students in applying for stipends and ensured they received the financial support offered by the government. No grievances were reported during the year.





The SC/ST Cell was formed with the Principal, Dr. S. Jayasree, as chairperson, Dr. Bhargavan as convener, Dr. Stalin Das P., Ms. Divya (office staff), and Aswani P. (2nd B.Com student) as members.

Members verified the admission records, confirming that 108 out of 110 reserved seats for SC/ST students in UG courses were filled, and all 26 reserved seats in PG courses were filled.

The first and second-term meetings of the cell took place on 28.08.2019 and 18.11.2019, respectively, in the Seminar Hall, presided over by the principal. The cell recorded details of SC/ST students and available scholarships. Rules, regulations, scholarship details, and other relevant information were presented to newly admitted students during the induction program coordinated by IQAC.

The cell verified the remedial class registers and the Scholar Support Programme records, ensuring SC/ST student participation. It also ensured the supply of study materials and monitored SC/ST student participation in Career Guidance cell activities. No grievances were reported during the year.






The SC/ST Cell was formed with the Principal, Dr. Edakkotte Shaji, as chairperson, Dr. Bhargavan as convener, Dr. Stalin Das P., Ms. Divya (office staff), and Aswani P. (2nd B.Com student) as members.

The first-term meeting took place on 02.09.2020 in the Seminar Hall. The cell monitored UG and PG admissions, ensuring the implementation of reservation rules. Out of the 117 seats earmarked for SC/ST students, 113 were filled in UG courses, and 30 out of 32 reserved seats were filled in PG courses.

The cell actively coordinated and resolved issues related to SC/ST student admissions and monitored financial aid for hostel accommodation. It guided students to participate in the Scholar Support Programme and other college academic development programs. Members regularly contacted tutors to check SC/ST student participation in online classes and ensured financial assistance for online education.

The second-term meeting was held on 04.03.2021 to follow up on decisions from the first-term meeting. No grievances were reported during the year.





The SC/ST cell was reconstituted with Edakkotte Shaji as chairperson, Dr. Ravi K. P, Dr. Subha C., Dr. Bhargavan, Dr. Muneer E, Dr. Saleem U K A, Dr. Pramod E, Ms. Leena K (Lab assistant) and Niranjan T were selected as members.

The first meeting of the newly constituted cell was convened on 28.09.2021. The committee members monitored the implementation of the reservation policy in the institution. Out of the 111 seats reserved for SC/ST students, 110 students got admitted in the UG courses and out of the 27 seats reserved for SC/ST students, 25 students were admitted in the PG courses. The details of the scholarship schemes were circulated to the students through tutors. The rules/regulations, scholarship details and other related matters were presented to newly admitted students during the induction programme coordinated by IQAC.

The second term meeting of the SC/ST cell was held on 14.03.2022 at the Seminar Hall. The cell identified SC/ST students who are lagging behind in their studies and implemented strategies to improve their academic performance.

The Cell ensured the timely disbursing of various scholarships for SC/ST applicants.







The first meeting of the SC/ST Cell was held on 24.08.2022 in the Seminar Hall. The SC/ST committee for the academic year 2022-23 was constituted with the Principal as coordinator and six other members. Dr. Ravi P., Assistant Professor, Department of Malayalam, was appointed as coordinator for the academic year. The members included Dr. Subha C., Dr. Bhargavan, Dr. Muneer C.P., Ms. Leena (Lab assistant), and Niranjan T. (final year B.Com student).

The meeting analyzed admission data, noting that 114 out of 121 reserved UG seats and 30 out of 32 reserved PG seats were filled. The event was inaugurated by the principal, Dr. Edakkotte Shaji, with a welcoming address by Dr. Subair K. A., the nodal officer for UG admissions.
